



Day 1: Singapore – Kunming – Dali

Meet at Singapore Changi Airport and depart for **Kunming**, the “Spring City” and gateway to Yunnan.

Upon arrival, transfer by high-speed rail to Dali, enjoying scenic views as city landscapes gradually give way to lakes and mountains. As the train enters the Erhai Plain and the Cangshan range appears, your Yunnan journey begins.

Meals: Not Included

Day 2: Dali

After breakfast, visit **Chongsheng Temple & the Three Pagodas** (including electric shuttle), Dali’s most iconic Buddhist landmark. Dating back over a thousand years to the Nanzhao and Dali Kingdoms, the pagodas stand against the Cangshan Mountains and face Erhai Lake, symbolising Dali’s rich religious and cultural heritage.

Continue with a walk through **Dali Ancient Town**, where stone-paved streets connect Bai ethnic residences, old city walls, and archways. Traditional lifestyles blend seamlessly with cafés and artsy spaces, creating Dali’s signature relaxed atmosphere.


In the afternoon, enjoy a specially arranged **Erhai Lakeside Afternoon Tea**, sitting by the lake with mountain views and soaking in the tranquil beauty and slow-living charm of Dali.

Day 3: Dali – Lijiang

After breakfast, travel to **Lijiang**, a highland ancient town known for its snow-capped mountains and flowing waterways. Visit **Black Dragon Pool Park**, where clear waters from Yulong Snow Mountain reflect traditional pavilions, stone bridges, and distant snow peaks.

Continue to the UNESCO-listed **Lijiang Ancient Town**, where canals, stone streets, and traditional Naxi wooden houses form a distinctive highland water town. Strolling through the old town offers a glimpse into Naxi culture, Dongba script, and centuries of history.

Day 4: Lijiang

After breakfast, visit **Yulong Snow Mountain Scenic Area** and take a cable car to the **Glacier Park** at around 4,500 metres, where snow-capped peaks and glacial landscapes rise above the clouds.

Continue to **Blue Moon Valley**, known for its layered pools of shimmering blue and green waters formed by snowmelt, perfect for photography.

In the afternoon, enjoy the open-air performance **Impression Lijiang**, set against Yulong Snow Mountain and showcasing Naxi, Bai, and other ethnic cultures.

End the day with a **Snow Mountain Scenic Hotpot**, enjoying a warm meal in the crisp highland air.

Remarks: If the main cable car is suspended due to weather or unforeseen circumstances, the visit will be replaced with the Yunshanping cable car.

Day 5: Lijiang – Shangri-La

After breakfast, travel to **Shangri-La**, a highland city made famous by James Hilton’s vision of an ideal land. Rich in Tibetan culture and spiritual atmosphere, its temples, traditions, and mountain setting reflect the deep heritage of the Tibetan Plateau.

In the afternoon, visit **Pudacuo National Park** (including eco-shuttle), home to alpine lakes, meadows, forests, and wetlands. Clear waters and peaceful landscapes showcase the beauty of highland ecology.

Continue to **Dukezong Ancient Town**, strolling along ancient stone streets, before heading to **Guishan Park** to view the world’s largest prayer wheel and experience the calm, sacred ambience of Tibetan culture.

Day 6: Shangri-La – Shaxi


After breakfast, visit **Songzanlin Monastery**, the largest Tibetan Buddhist monastery in Yunnan, known as the “Little Potala Palace.” Its grand halls, murals, and monastic life offer deep insight into Tibetan culture and Shangri-La’s religious history.

Continue to **Tiger Leaping Gorge**, one of the world’s deepest gorges, where the roaring Jinsha River cuts through towering cliffs, creating a dramatic and awe-inspiring landscape.


Arrive in **Shaxi** in the evening and check in to your hotel for rest.


Day 7: Shaxi – Dali (Xizhou)

After breakfast, visit **Shaxi Ancient Town**, the only well-preserved ancient market town along the historic Tea Horse Road. Walk through Sideng Street, the old theatre stage, and traditional inns still in use today, where traces of ancient trade blend naturally with the calm rhythm of rural life.

Return to Dali for a leisurely stroll along the **Erhai Ecological Corridor**, a scenic lakeside pathway created through ecological restoration. Enjoy close-up views of Erhai Lake, surrounding wetlands, and reflections of the Cangshan Mountains.

Continue to **Xizhou Ancient Town**, famed for its well-preserved Bai ethnic courtyard houses. White-walled residences, grey-tiled roofs, and everyday village scenes offer an authentic glimpse into Bai culture and its relaxed, slow-living lifestyle.
