
Day 6: Beijing – Singapore

Day 1: Singapore – Beijing

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport and depart on a direct flight to **Beijing**, China's capital and a city rich in political, cultural, and historical significance.

Upon arrival, meet your professional guide and private driver at the airport and transfer to the hotel for check-in assistance. After a short rest, enjoy free time to relax, adjust to the local environment, and prepare for the journey ahead.

Day 2: Tiananmen Square – Forbidden City – Jingshan Park

After breakfast, visit **Tiananmen Square**, one of the world's largest public squares and a key political and historical landmark, with views of the Great Hall of the People.

Continue to the **Forbidden City**, the former imperial palace of the Ming and Qing dynasties. Its grand halls, red walls, and golden roofs showcase the finest examples of traditional Chinese imperial architecture.

Then proceed to **Jingshan Park**, where a short climb offers panoramic views of the Forbidden City and Beijing's central axis—an ideal photo stop.

Day 3: Mutianyu Great Wall – Temple of Heaven

After breakfast, travel to the **Mutianyu Great Wall**, located in the northern mountains of Beijing. Built mainly during the Ming Dynasty, this well-preserved section is known for its towering walls and dense watchtowers winding across the mountain ridges. Walking along the wall offers sweeping views and a powerful sense of China's history and engineering brilliance.

After lunch, return to the city to visit the **Temple of Heaven**, where Ming and Qing emperors once performed sacred rituals to pray for good harvests. The park's symmetrical layout and iconic architecture reflect ancient Chinese cosmology, creating a solemn and tranquil atmosphere amid centuries-old cypress trees.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 4: Summer Palace – Old Summer Palace (Yuanmingyuan)

After breakfast, visit the **Summer Palace**, the largest and best-preserved imperial garden in China. Built during the Qing Dynasty, the garden centres around Kunming Lake and Longevity Hill, blending natural landscapes with palace architecture in harmony. A **Kunming Lake boat ride** is specially arranged, offering scenic views from the water and a glimpse into the elegance of royal leisure life.

Continue to the **Old Summer Palace (Yuanmingyuan Ruins Park)**. Once known as the "Garden of Gardens," it was a masterpiece of imperial landscaping that combined Chinese and Western designs. Though largely destroyed in the 19th century, the preserved ruins stand today as a powerful reminder of China's history and cultural heritage.

Day 5: Prince Gong's Mansion – Hutong Rickshaw – Shichahai – Drum & Bell Towers – Nanluoguxiang

After breakfast, visit **Prince Gong's Mansion**, the largest and best-preserved Qing Dynasty princely residence in Beijing, showcasing classic courtyard architecture and aristocratic life.

Enjoy a **Hutong rickshaw ride** through traditional alleyways and siheyuan courtyards, offering an authentic glimpse into old Beijing's residential culture and daily life.

After lunch, explore the scenic **Shichahai** area, followed by visits to the **Drum Tower and Bell Tower** to learn about ancient timekeeping and city planning. End the day with a stroll along **Nanluoguxiang**, where historic hutongs blend with modern cafés and boutique shops.
