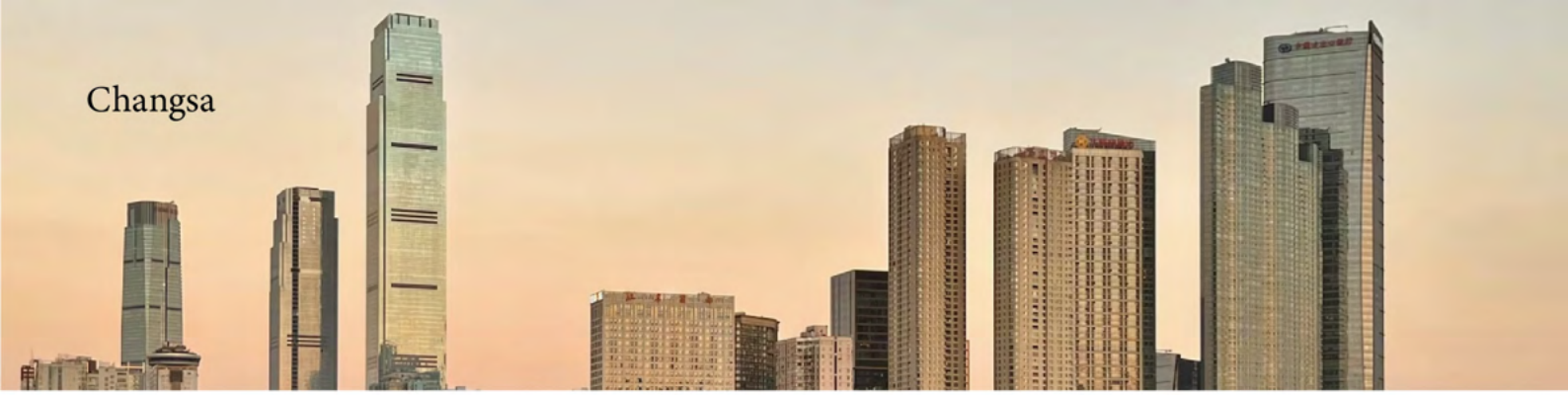

## Day 1: Singapore – Changsha

Meet at Singapore Changi Airport and depart for **Changsha**, the capital city of Hunan Province. Upon arrival, you will be met by your professional guide and transferred to the hotel for check-in. The rest of the day is at leisure, allowing you to rest after the flight and prepare for the journey ahead.

## Day 2: Changsha – Fenghuang Ancient Town – Tuojiang River Night View

After breakfast, depart Changsha and travel into the scenic mountains of western Hunan. Along the way, city views gradually give way to tranquil valleys and rivers.

Arrive at **Fenghuang Ancient Town**, built along the **Tuojiang River**. Stilted houses, stone streets, and Ming–Qing architecture reflect the unique heritage of the Miao and Tujia cultures. Take the **Fenghuang Maglev Sightseeing Tram** for a panoramic view of the town.

In the evening, enjoy a **Tuojiang River Night Cruise**, where lantern-lit houses and bridges reflect beautifully on the water, creating a calm and poetic atmosphere.

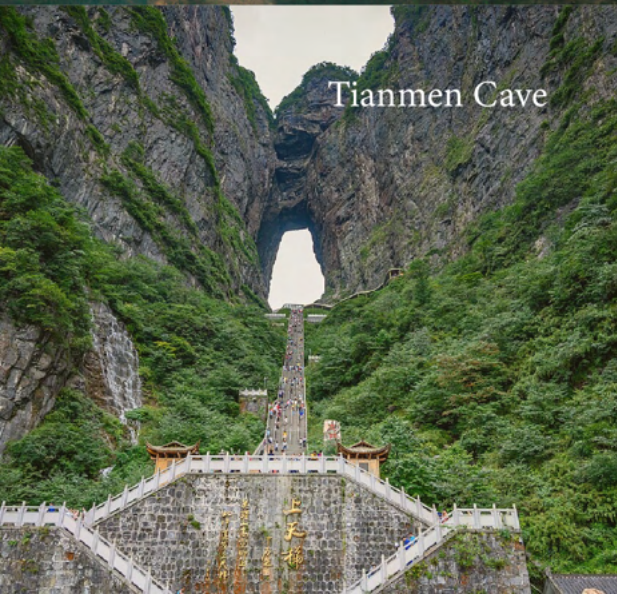
## Day 3: Morong Miao Village – Furong Ancient Town – Zhangjiajie

After breakfast, visit **Morong Miao Village**, known as the “First Miao Village of the Borderlands.” Traditional wooden stilt houses line the mountainside, and locals in colourful attire welcome visitors with folk songs and ceremonial rice wine, offering an authentic introduction to Miao culture and customs.

Next, continue to **Furong Ancient Town**, a historic town with over 2,000 years of history, famous for its waterfall flowing through the settlement. Stone streets, stilted houses, and cascading water create a unique scene where nature and heritage blend seamlessly.

In the late afternoon, travel onward to **Zhangjiajie**. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel and rest in preparation for the days of natural exploration ahead.

## Day 4: Zhangjiajie (Tianmen Mountain National Forest Park)

After breakfast, head to the iconic **Tianmen Mountain National Forest Park** for a breathtaking high-altitude experience. Take one of the world’s longest cable cars, ascending from the city to the mountain summit at approximately 1,500 metres. Along the way, deep valleys, sheer cliffs, and rolling clouds unfold beneath your feet.

At the summit, stroll along cliffside walkways and enjoy expansive views of the surrounding peaks. Visit the legendary **Tianmen Cave**, a massive natural arch known as the “Gateway to Heaven.” Climb the famous 999 Heavenly Steps, and stand before the cave as clouds drift through the mountains, highlighting the awe-inspiring power of nature.

## Day 5: Zhangjiajie National Forest Park – Yuanjiajie – Tianzi Mountain

After breakfast, explore the **Zhangjiajie National Forest Park**, a UNESCO World Natural Heritage Site famous for its towering quartz sandstone pillars.

Take the cable car up **Tianzi Mountain**, where layers of dramatic peaks rise from mist-filled valleys, resembling a traditional Chinese ink painting. Continue to Yuanjiajie, home to the iconic stone columns that inspired the “Avatar Mountains,” offering Zhangjiajie’s most recognisable and surreal scenery.

**Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

## Day 6: Golden Whip Stream – Zhangjiajie Grand Canyon Glass Bridge

After breakfast, enjoy a leisurely walk along **Golden Whip Stream**, where clear waters flow through forested valleys beneath towering rock formations, offering a calm and refreshing nature experience.

Later, visit the **Zhangjiajie Grand Canyon Glass Bridge**, suspended high above the canyon. Walk across the transparent bridge for breathtaking views of the deep gorge below—an unforgettable blend of natural scenery and modern engineering.

**Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

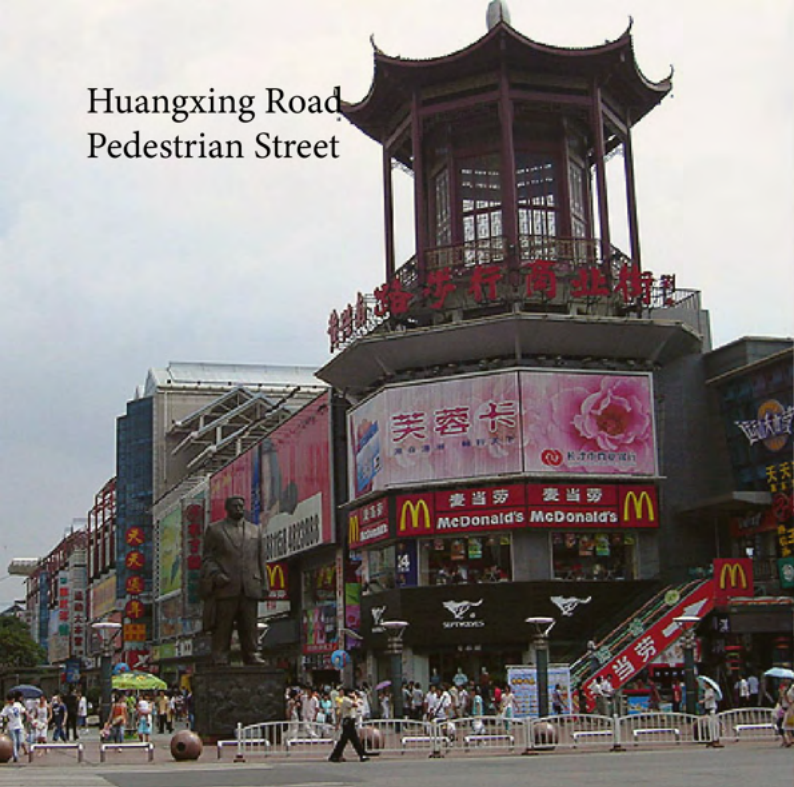

## Day 7: Return to Changsha – City Highlights

After breakfast, depart Zhangjiajie and return to Changsha. Upon arrival, visit the **Hunan Provincial Museum**, home to a remarkable collection of historical artefacts, including treasures from the Mawangdui Han Tombs. The exhibits provide insight into ancient Chu–Han civilisation, daily life, and artistic achievements from over 2,000 years ago.

Later, visit **Du Fu River Pavilion**, overlooking the Xiang River, where you can reflect on the poetic legacy of Du Fu. In the evening, stroll along **Huangxing Road Pedestrian Street**, filled with lively crowds, local snacks, and illuminated streetscapes, capturing the vibrant spirit of Changsha by night.

## Day 8: Changsha – Singapore

After breakfast, take time to pack your memories of towering sandstone peaks, ancient towns, and the cultural richness of western Hunan. At the scheduled time, a private transfer will take you to the airport for your return flight to Singapore, bringing this unforgettable Zhangjiajie journey to a perfect close.

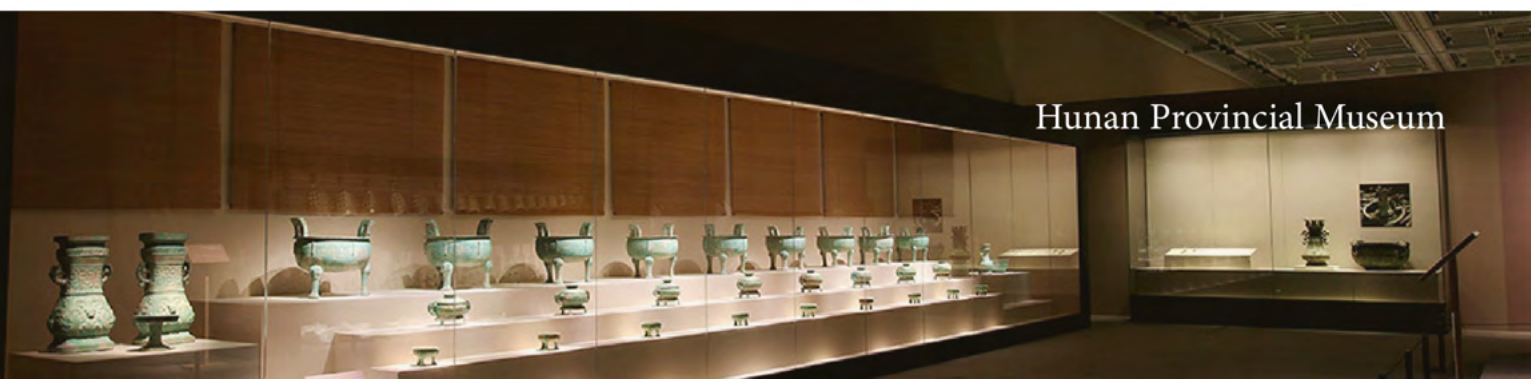
